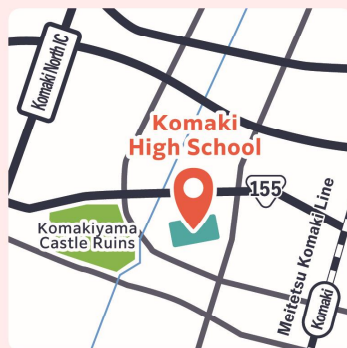

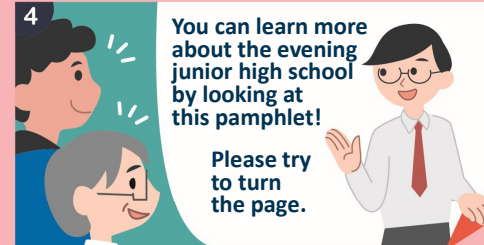

Here's what an evening junior high school is like



Classes are held five days a week, from Monday to Friday.

Students learn the same subjects as those in daytime junior high schools.

Classes are run by certified teachers.

Upon completion of the classes, you will be considered having completed your junior high school education.

The following persons can enroll

Those who are over the age of compulsory education (15 years old), live or work in Aichi Prefecture, and meet any of the following criteria are eligible to enroll.

Those who have not graduated from an elementary or junior high school

Foreign nationals can also enroll

Those who have not received sufficient education and wish to repeat their studies

Fees for educational materials, participation in events, and school lunches must be paid.

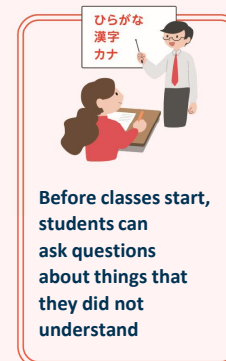
About time allotment

As with daytime junior high schools, in principle, students will attend classes for three years.

*This can be shortened or extended up to 6 years depending on the learning situation and other factors.

The daily class schedule is 4 periods (1 period: 40 minutes).

Hours	Contents
17 : 20~17 : 30	Homeroom
17 : 30~18 : 10	1st period
18 : 10~18 : 40	School lunch <small>*for those who wish to take it.</small>
18 : 40~19 : 20	2nd period
19 : 25~20 : 05	3rd period
20 : 10~20 : 50	4th period
20 : 50~20 : 55	Homeroom



About courses

Students choose one of the following courses for one year.

Courses based on learning situation

Basic course

→ Content equivalent to 1st grade junior high school

Standard course

→ Contents equivalent to 2nd grade of junior high school

Challenge course

→ Contents equivalent to 3rd grade of junior high school

Including relearning subjects taught at elementary school

Courses focusing on Japanese language instruction

Japanese beginner course

→ Japanese beginner to elementary level

Japanese basic course

→ Japanese elementary to intermediate level

*Various subjects are also covered.
